Digital Photography in the K-12 Classroom – 100% Online!

In this 1 sem. hr. course participants will gain knowledge of the basic digital camera operation and photo editing. In addition, this professional development will introduce effective methods to integrate digital photography into the curriculum. Does not include camera.

EdTech Connects IVDL Series: Web 2.0 or 3.0: Wikis, Blogs, and Podcasts

Explore the world of Web 2.0/3.0, Wikis, Blogs, and Podcasts. In wikis learn how to easily create and edit collaborative community websites. The blog workshop will explore how information is maintained with regular entries of commentary, descriptions of events, or other material such as graphics or video. In Web 2.0, educators will be introduced the remarkable phenomenon of user-generated content and discover innovative uses of technology and approaches to pedagogy. Furthermore, in Web 3.0, also referred to as the Intelligent Web, you will explore the provision of a more productive, personalized, and intuitive environment on the Web. Lastly in podcasting, see how students can benefit with the information of finding, subscribing, downloading and listening to or watching a podcast applicable to education.

Google Tools for Educator

Google loves educators! Join us as we explore Google tools that focus on the core areas of 21st century learning skills: communicate, collaborate and create. Take a quick look at Picasa (a photo editing and online sharing application), SketchUp (a computer assisted drawing application), Gmail, and many other Google applications: Docs, Calendar, Sites, Earth, Custom Search Engine, and more as time permits. Time will be given to create an iGoogle page, customizing it with gadgets, resources, and tabs for sharing with students.

Learning Strategies and Resources for Students Who Are Struggling

All students don't learn in the same way. In this class you will learn online resources that can be combined with effective teaching strategies to maximize learning opportunities for struggling students. Resources will focus on basic skill development and assessment and will follow the CAST (Center for Applied Special Technology) guidelines for Universal Design for Learners.

Making the Most of Your SMART Board – 100% Online

This 1 sem. hr., guided online training will focus on intermediate-to-advanced level features of the SMART Board and SMART Notebook software. Emphasis in this course will be on features of the SMART Board to create activities to support students' higher level thinking skills. Prerequisite: Basic computer and Internet skills and 6 -12 months experience using a SMART Board on a weekly basis.

Media and Information Resources in 21st Century Schools – 100% Online!

A series of professional development modules which consists of hands-on activities to develop a variety of technological skills to support classroom curriculum technology integration incorporating 21st Century skills. Learn how additional modes of technology can be utilized to enhance the way classroom instruction is delivered. Participants will complete a minimum of 18 modules.

Mimio Interactive Whiteboard – Basics & Advanced (Windows & Mac)

This full-day training will familiarize participants with the mimio interactive whiteboard system. Designed for the new user, the focus will be on integration strategies for using this tool as well as lots of hands-on practice using the system, software, and mimioconnect online resources.

Promethean Activ-Classroom – Basics & Advanced (Windows & Mac)

Participants will receive hands-on training in use of the ActivBoard interactive whiteboard system, ActivExpression and ActiVote learner response systems, ActivSlates, and the new ActivInspire software that serves as the backbone of this system.

Also covered will be basic video editing to enhance and pull together your footage; research on the power of video to increase student engagement and achievement.
